

**LIMITATION ON THE INTRODUCTION OF BILLS AND
UPCOMING DEADLINES**

- A standing committee, other than the Budget Committee, may introduce a total of **five** committee bills in **each year** of a biennial session (Assembly Rule 47(d)).
- A Member may introduce no more than **40** bills (includes Constitutional Amendments) in the **regular session** (i.e., no more than 40 bills total over the two-year period) (Assembly Rule 49(a)).
- A Member may introduce no more than **five** resolutions (e.g., House, Concurrent and Joint Resolutions) in the **regular session** (i.e., no more than five resolutions total over the two-year period) (Assembly Rule 49(b)).

Some key deadlines for you to note:

Friday, January 22, 2016, is the last day to submit **bill requests** to the Office of Legislative Counsel.

Friday, February 19, 2016, is the last day for bills to be **introduced** (Joint Rule 61(b)(4), Joint Rule 54(a)).
